CONDITIONS OF ENROLLMENT

TRANSPORTATION

⇒ Transportation is a personal responsibility. Please contact your Corps Officer to see if they are making travel arrangements as a group.

PAYMENT

⇒ All fees and applications must be submitted to your Corps Officer.

CHAPERONES

⇒ Every Corps is responsible to provide an adequate number of chaperones for all male/female delegates.

MEDICAL

- ⇒ Any additional medical expense (medications, treatment, and transportation) will become the responsibility of the parent or legal guardian.
- ⇒ In case of medical emergency, every effort will be made to contact the parent or legal guardian.
- ⇒ Delegates bringing any medication to retreat must have medication in original containers. An adequate supply of prescribed medication must be sent for the duration of the weekend.

GUIDELINES

- ⇒ Electronic devices are permitted at retreat but not during sessions.
- ⇒ The Salvation Army is not responsible for loss or damage of personal items.
- ⇒ Out of respect for others, music must be kept to an acceptable level.
