The following guidelines are strictly enforced for Youth Together. Please read these guidelines and be aware that by signing your application to register for Youth Together, you are confirming your promise to conduct yourself in accordance with the following:

- I will respect the curfews and will not leave my room after hours.
- I will not leave the event accommodation at any time without prior permission.
- I will attend all scheduled activities.

The following items are not allowed at Youth Together and I will not take part in or bring these items to Youth Together: *Tobacco Roughhousing Alcohol Drugs Gambling Foul language*

Electronic devices are permitted but not in sessions. Music players if brought must be used with consideration of other campers. Loud music will not be tolerated.

Males are not permitted in the females room. Females are not permitted in the males rooms.

I understand that failure to observe the above stated rules will result in my immediate dismissal and loss of my registration fee.
