RESPONSIBILITIES:

The youth pastor will provide a discipleship and outreach ministry to youth (for assigned age groupings) from the Church and the local community.

The successful candidate will be responsible for:

Contributing to the spiritual and pastoral development of the youth in the church by mentoring, discipling, encouraging, and modeling appropriate Christian attitudes and behaviours

Developing, implementing, maintaining and evaluating programs/ministries relevant to the youth of the church and the community at large; planning and conducting creative worship services, evangelistic outreach, pastoral care programs (including on-going visitation), and Bible studies as applicable

Assisting in the planning of assimilation strategies and events as required to promote incorporation into the church fellowship

Praying with and or leading youth and family members to faith in Jesus Christ as opportunity permits

Developing and implementing appropriate leadership development programs for youth and those involved in youth leadership; recruiting, orienting and training volunteer leaders

Working as a key team member with the church's administrative and pastoral care givers in corporate problem-solving for the benefit of the church and individuals

Knowing and acting in accordance with security procedures of the church ensuring safety and confidentiality of participants and information

Interacting with community partners and resources to provide services to youth; may include participation on community committees

Maintaining written records/logs of activities (including activity reports and statistical information)

Organizing and holding fundraising events throughout the year

Performing other duties as assigned
